O WHAT IS SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST?

It happens when the heart stops beating, suddenly and unexpectedly. The only way to prevent it is to get tested and watch for warning signs.

O WHAT ARE THE WARNING SIGNS?

Sometimes warning signs happen and sometimes they don't. Watch out for fainting or seizures during and after exercise, unexplained shortness of breath, rapid heart rate, extreme dizziness or fatigue and unexplained sudden death in family (SIDS, drownings and auto accidents)

WHAT HAPPENS AT A HEART SCREENING?

- 1. You fill out a medical history form (it's short).
- We'll check your blood pressure, height and weight. You'll also get an ECG exam (stickies on your chest).
- You might get an echocardiogram. It takes a picture of your heart.
- The cardiologists evalute all of this to to see if there are any concerns.

WHAT IS SIMON'S FUND
