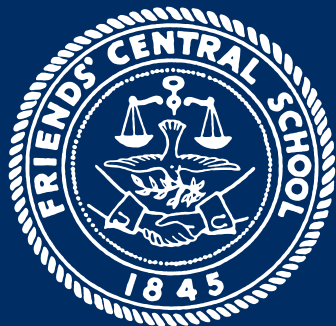

- Incorporate the School's bird blind, garden, and pond into curriculum and lessons
- Serve on Garden committee and help to maintain bird blind, garden, and pond
- Manage and purchase supplies for science curriculum

- Training in teaching multiple methodologies
