

## MEDICATION PROCEDURES AND IMPORTANT REQUEST FROM THE SCHOOL NURSES

School Regulations Require Completed Health Forms

Our goal at Friends' Central is to provide your child with safe, quality health care during school hours. Please ensure that we have the following forms on file:

EMERGENCY CONSENT

PHYSICIAN'S REPORT OF PHYSICAL EXAM (Forms are valid for one year from the date of exam.)

DENTAL EXAMINATION (Required in Kindergarten, 3rd grade, and 7th grade. A Dental Examination form is not required in Nursery and Pre-K.)

## **MEDICATION DURING SCHOOL HOURS**

All medications are administered through the health office. This assures that your child receives the medication and that no other student acquires it by accident. Should your child need to take medication during school hours, school regulations require:

- 1. a written order from a physician with the drug name, dose, time and reason for the medication. (Form is available from the school nurse.)
- 2. a written request from a parent or guardian asking for the medication to be given to the student by the school staff. (Form is available from the school nurse.)
- 3. the medication be brought to school in its original, pharmacylabeled, child-proof container.
